Job Description

Job Requirements

- ♣ Experience teaching various sized groups of students (two years-preferred)
- ♣ Four-year College degree preferred
- ♣ Updated Criminal Background, Child Abuse, and FBI Fingerprint Clearances

Job Details

- ♣ Design your own STEM-based curriculum with hands-on activities
- ♣ Choose dates and times for camp(s). Each camp is week-long (M-F) with 15 hours of instruction time.
- ♣ Determine appropriate age group for camp (K-4, K-8, 3-8, etc.)
- ♣ Obtain own materials or utilize those in-house. Purchased materials will be reimbursed to the amount specified below.
- ♣ Can design/instruct up to 2-3 camps
- ♣ Expected to handle discipline issues that arise during camp session
- ♣ Manage volunteers, assign tasks as needed, report bad behavior to STEM Educator
- ♣ Must be able to work with students from diverse backgrounds and family settings
- ♣ Must multitask in a fast pace, high pressure environment
- ♣ Must take initiative to creatively solve problems and to participate and communicate as a member of a team

Additional Information

- ♣ Salary: \$375 (\$25/hour) for one week of camp (15 hours of instruction)
- ♣ Supply budget: \$250 maximum
- ♣ First week of camps: 17 June – 21 June
- ♣ Last week of camps: 12 August – 16 August
- ♣ Two sessions per day, AM (9.00-12.00) and PM (1.00-4.00)
- ♣ Fourth of July week only has 4 days of camp
- ♣ Registration for camps open 1 March, information must be finalized by then
- ♣ Classroom Aide Volunteers for camps are recruited and distributed between camps based on size.
